BACKGROUND

In the heart of Mexico's rural Indigenous communities, iConnectED is breaking down the barriers to education, one connection at a time. Faced with the challenges of limited internet access and the high demands of traditional online learning platforms, these communities needed a solution that was as resilient as they are.

Before iConnectED, students and educators struggled with the limitations of Google Classroom, which required high bandwidth and Gmail accounts, often resulting in the need for physical printouts and a confusing mess of WhatsApp messages for education. iConnectED revolutionized this process by leveraging WhatsApp's API to build a more structured, centralized and seamless learning solution.
